## Description

The role will be based in Europe (preferably Liege, Belgium) and reports to the Director, Early Stage Program Management but is expected to have extensive interaction with key staff in the USA and other international locations.

**Key Objectives:** To champion the progress of early stage products in the Group’s portfolio through development and commercialisation, thereby contributing to the achievement of the Group’s commercial and strategic goals.
