Description

Telix Pharmaceuticals is searching for a Data Manager to fill this newly created position and contribute to the achievement of the Group's data management goals. The successful candidate will hold responsibility for planning, designing, developing and facilitating the collection and management of internally and externally generated information and data. Additionally, the Data Manager will lead Telix's Data Loss Prevention strategy and contribute to safeguarding the IT integrity of the organisation.

Reporting to the Global Director of IT, the role is based in Indianapolis though interaction with key staff in Australia and other international locations will be required. In addition to the primary objectives listed above, other responsibilities may include:

- Managing Telix's SharePoint platform, including all sites and subsites of SharePoint (Intranet and Extranet).
- Where appropriate, lead, facilitate, or participate in data collection projects with external parties that Telix engages for various services including, but not limited to: CROs, health care data metrics providers, suppliers & partners/collaborators.
- Where appropriate, assist with periodic reviews (and reporting) of Cyber Security audits and user data access audits.
- Ensure data is easily accessible to internal staff and teams whilst ensuring appropriate access rights are compliant with jurisdictional data sovereignties and their policies such as: CFR Part 11, GDPR, and others as required, as well as Telix's corporate policies and SOPs.
- Assist in localised IT support requests from time to time.

To be considered, candidates should hold a Bachelors' degree (or higher) in a relevant discipline and have demonstrable experience in a similar role. Experience in a similar industry will be highly advantageous!
