Description

Telix is still growing and looking for a *Product Portfolio Project Manager, PSMA* to join our team. This is a newly created role, working directly alongside the Vice President, PSMA Program. This role will be responsible for project managing all aspects of the timely and efficient quality delivery of Telix PSMA products from early-stage development through to commercialisation withing budget and timelines, proactively and responsibly. Key accountabilities will include:

- Managing all aspects of the product development master plan including budget, milestone tracking, resource planning and reporting
- Contributing to integrated product development plans with the core project team and across a matrix team design
- Managing all product-related documents such as the product development master plan, project plan, budget, resource forecasting and tracking, identifying and managing project risks
- Monitoring all project activities performed by external partners to ensure the quality of the service with respect to the mutually agreed timelines and budget
- Working as part of the Portfolio Management team to manage risk
- Collaborating with other functional groups within Telix to support milestone achievement and to manage study issues and obstacles
- Acting as the key internal contact for specific projects under your management.

To be considered for the role, you require tertiary qualifications in life sciences with ideally, a PhD. You must also demonstrate practical work experience in a similar role for a pharmaceutical/biotechnology company and/or similar project management roles in a parallel business. Proven leadership skills, lateral thinking capability and agility are all key attributes required for this role. You must also possess a strong understanding of the drug development industry (drug/device/technology/etc.) as well as Good Manufacturing Practice, Good Clinical Practice & International Council for Harmonization.
